Statement on Budget from Acting-Interim Chair, Assemblymember Susan Talamantes Eggman and Vice Chair, Senator Connie M. Leyva

SACRAMENTO – Today we advance a budget that provides greater opportunities for California's working families. The two greatest increases in the 2018-19 budget help families rise up from the deepest levels of poverty and address access and workforce needs in our early learning community. We continued our commitment to childcare and, with this budget, have made great gains.
